5. High level review of the Migration Assessment tool results
 - a. Identify SharePoint Limitations - Are you familiar with EVERY site within your SharePoint Farm? It's a time consuming and manual process to look for large files, checked-out documents, or lists where the limits have been exceeded.
 - b. Assess Your SharePoint Security - How has your SharePoint governance been followed? Are you 100% confident that users will only see content they have access to in your new environment? We analyse key areas in SharePoint security to let you know if your system is secure, and provide recommendations to fix issues before you migrate.
 - c. Evaluate Your Storage Needs - The fastest migrations only move content that is necessary. Identify stale data, unused documents, large videos and unique file formats that aren't wanted in your future SharePoint environment. We not only look at what is in your system and predict how it will grow in the future, but also provide feedback on how to manage your storage costs.
